MONDAY

Pray for wisdom surrounding the renewed Ebola outbreak in the Democratic Republic of Congo, that GCS-supported ministry efforts would continue with discernment and practical wisdom amid health risks, fear, and logistical disruption.

TUESDAY

Pray for GCS engagement among displaced communities across Sudan and neighbouring regions, that families affected by conflict and instability would encounter practical compassion, biblical hope, and the transforming message of Christ.

WEDNESDAY

Pray for believers in Iran, Lebanon, Syria, and Israel as tensions continue across the Middle East, that the Lord would restrain violence, protect vulnerable communities, and strengthen local churches seeking to minister faithfully amid instability.

4

THURSDAY

Pray that the spiritual legacy connected to the Apostle Paul's arrival in Malta would not remain merely historical, but that a new generation would encounter Christ personally and respond with sincere faith, obedience, and Gospel urgency.

5

FRIDAY

Pray for the GCS team preparing for ministry in Malta, that every conversation, partnership, and ministry opportunity would be guided by wisdom, unity, and sensitivity to the deeper spiritual needs present across the island nation.

SATURDAY

Pray for the We Are One Conference taking place today in Malta, that believers would be strengthened in unity, biblical conviction, and Gospel urgency, and that genuine spiritual renewal would shape churches and ministries represented there.

SUNDAY

Pray for the GCS Evangelism Masterclass taking place in Malta today, that those attending would gain theological depth, practical understanding, and renewed courage for proclaiming Christ clearly across cultures, communities, and resistant environments.

Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

MONDAY

Pray for GCS missionaries serving across Central Asia, that relationships formed over long periods would open meaningful doors for discipleship, and that local believers would remain spiritually steadfast despite social pressure, and cultural resistance.

TUESDAY

Pray for wisdom and protection over GCS missionaries serving in Somalia, that every conversation, and ministry opportunity would be guided carefully, and that hidden Gospel work would produce enduring spiritual fruit despite the significant risks.

10

WEDNESDAY

Intercede for GCS discipleship initiatives among former Muslims coming to faith in Christ, that new believers would grow securely in biblical truth despite social rejection, family pressure, and significant personal risk.

11

THURSDAY

Pray for the evangelistic event taking place today in Warrington, United Kingdom, that hearts would be receptive to the Gospel, conversations would be spiritually significant, and many would respond sincerely to Christ with repentance and faith.

12

FRIDAY

Pray for GCS teams ministering throughout Guatemala during this period of intensified outreach, that churches would be strengthened, and vulnerable communities encouraged through practical compassion, and sustained Gospel-centred partnership.

SATURDAY

Lift up in prayer GCS missionaries serving in Uzbekistan, that wisdom and discernment would shape every interaction, and that believers living under pressure would grow in courage, spiritual maturity, and confidence in the truth of Scripture.

SUNDAY

Pray for the ongoing GCS mission in Croatia, that outreach among churches, young adults, and local communities would produce lasting spiritual fruit, and that partnerships formed would strengthen long-term Gospel witness throughout the region.

MONDAY

Pray for persecuted believers in North Korea, Eritrea, Afghanistan, and Somalia, that despite isolation, surveillance, and severe restrictions upon Christian faith, the Church would remain spiritually alive, resilient under pressure, and rooted in biblical truth.

16

TUESDAY

Pray for GCS humanitarian response efforts in conflict-affected and economically fragile regions, that practical aid would be delivered with wisdom, and compassion, opening meaningful opportunities for Gospel witness among those experiencing hardship.

17

WEDNESDAY

Intercede for GCS discipleship efforts among new believers in regions shaped by animism, folk religion, and spiritual fear, that biblical understanding would deepen and believers would stand firmly against confusion, compromise, and intimidation.

18

THURSDAY

Pray for GCS missionaries across Eastern Europe ministering in economically strained communities, that discouragement would not overwhelm them, and that the Lord would sustain faithful and compassionate ministry among people facing growing uncertainty.

19

FRIDAY

Pray for GCS prison ministry initiatives throughout the world, that incarcerated men and women would encounter Christ personally, and that genuine repentance would lead to transformed lives, restored relationships, and long-term discipleship beyond bars.

20

SATURDAY

Pray for GCS missionaries facing emotional exhaustion and spiritual fatigue after extended periods in demanding environments, that the Lord would renew their strength, guard their hearts, and sustain them with lasting encouragement and peace.

21

SUNDAY

Pray for the Church throughout Western Europe, where secularism continues reshaping public life and moral conviction, that believers would proclaim Christ with boldness, clarity, compassion, and unwavering confidence in the authority of biblical truth.

Intercede for GCS outreach among children and young people growing up in unstable homes and vulnerable communities, that early exposure to the Gospel would shape resilient faith, moral courage, and lasting spiritual direction.

TUESDAY

Pray for GCS engagement among Ukrainian refugees displaced across Poland, Germany, Romania, and neighbouring regions, that the Gospel would bring lasting hope, dignity, and spiritual healing to those carrying trauma, separation, and profound personal loss.

24

WEDNESDAY

Pray for wisdom for GCS leadership as strategic decisions are made concerning expansion into sensitive and restricted regions, that every step would reflect discernment, faithfulness to Scripture, and careful stewardship of entrusted resources.

25

THURSDAY

Pray that GCS missionaries serving in politically unstable regions would remain spiritually alert and unwavering in conviction, that amid uncertainty, corruption, and rising hostility, the Gospel would continue advancing through wisdom, endurance, and faithful witness.

26

FRIDAY

Lift up in prayer GCS evangelistic ministry among young adults wrestling with identity, anxiety, and spiritual confusion, so that biblical truth would cut through cultural noise and lead many toward repentance, healing, and genuine faith in Christ.

27

SATURDAY

Pray for believers serving discreetly across the Arabian Peninsula, that courage, wisdom, and spiritual discernment would guide every conversation, and that the Gospel would continue spreading quietly through trusted relationships and faithful discipleship.

28

SUNDAY

Pray that the global Church would recover a deeper understanding of sacrificial mission, recognising that many believers worldwide continue to serve Christ under genuine pressure, hardship, and personal risk, far beyond the visibility of mainstream attention.

MONDAY

Pray for communities affected by organised crime, violence, and exploitation throughout parts of Central and South America, that the Gospel would break cycles of fear and corruption, bringing restoration, hope, and transformed lives.

Pray for believers in Ethiopia navigating political uncertainty, ethnic tension, and economic hardship, that local churches would remain united in Christ and continue demonstrating compassion, reconciliation, and faithful Gospel witness.
