WEDNESDAY

Pray for GCS teams preparing for ministry assignments throughout the second half of 2026, that every journey, partnership, and strategic decision would be guided by wisdom, humility, discernment, and a dependence upon the leading of the Holy Spirit.

2

THURSDAY

Pray for nations emerging from conflict where peace remains fragile, and uncertainty continues to affect daily life, that reconciliation would take root, communities would rebuild with dignity, and local believers would demonstrate Christ's hope.

3

FRIDAY

Pray for the GCS mission beginning in Myanmar today, that international teams would minister with wisdom, courage, and cultural sensitivity, strengthening local believers and sharing Christ faithfully amid ongoing instability and displacement.

4

SATURDAY

Pray for communities suffering in humanitarian crises that receive little international attention, that practical needs be met, vulnerable people be protected, and the Gospel be proclaimed through compassionate, sustained Christian presence.

5

SUNDAY

Pray for GCS evangelistic engagement within rapidly growing urban centres, where loneliness, migration, social fragmentation, and spiritual confusion create both challenges and opportunities for meaningful Gospel witness and discipleship.

Acts 20:28

Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood.

6

MONDAY

Pray for indigenous church planters serving in difficult and often isolated regions, that they would remain faithful, be firmly rooted in Scripture, and be effective in establishing healthy, reproducing congregations that will continue to impact future generations.

7

TUESDAY

Pray for young evangelists being equipped through GCS training initiatives, that conviction, character, theological depth, and courage would develop together, producing a generation committed to clear, biblical, and faithful Gospel proclamation.

8

WEDNESDAY

Pray for Ethiopia as political, ethnic, and economic pressures continue affecting many communities, that churches would demonstrate reconciliation and compassion, and provide faithful Gospel witness within a nation facing significant social challenges.

9

THURSDAY

Pray for God's provision across every area of GCS ministry, that resources would be supplied in season, enabling evangelistic outreach, humanitarian response, leadership development, and effective mission engagement in difficult and underserved regions.

10

FRIDAY

Pray for local pastors, evangelists, and leaders partnering with GCS worldwide, that they would lead with integrity, perseverance, humility, and biblical conviction while navigating complex social, economic, and spiritual challenges within their communities.

11

SATURDAY

Pray for communities rebuilding after conflict and displacement, that trauma would be healed, families restored, livelihoods strengthened, and local churches equipped to serve as centres of hope, stability, reconciliation, and Gospel witness.

12

SUNDAY

Pray for ongoing planning, relationship-building, and strategic development connected to future ministry opportunities in Somalia, that wisdom, discernment, favour, and partnerships would guide every significant step forward in this sensitive mission field.

Ephesians 4:11–12

So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up.

13

MONDAY

Pray for online discipleship initiatives reaching seekers in restricted nations, that those responding to the Gospel would find sound biblical teaching, meaningful Christian community, and secure pathways for spiritual growth despite difficult circumstances.

14

TUESDAY

Pray for unity among churches, ministries, and mission partners working together across national, cultural, and denominational boundaries, that collaboration would strengthen Gospel impact, maximise resources, and reflect Christ's heart for His global Church.

15

WEDNESDAY

Pray for the GCS mission beginning in Poland today, that outreach among churches, rehabilitation ministries, prisons, schools, and local communities would bear lasting fruit, strengthening believers and drawing many people toward Christ through faithful witness.

16

THURSDAY

Pray for every conversation, testimony, teaching session, and ministry opportunity during the Poland mission that the Holy Spirit would prepare hearts and establish relationships that lead to ongoing discipleship, spiritual growth, and enduring Gospel impact.

17

FRIDAY

Pray for families trapped in bonded labour across South Asia that pathways to freedom would emerge, justice would prevail, exploitation would be exposed, and those rescued would encounter lasting hope, dignity, restoration, and freedom through Christ.

18

SATURDAY

Pray for ministry opportunities in Djibouti and throughout the wider Horn of Africa, that access would increase, trusted relationships would deepen, local believers would be strengthened, and new opportunities would emerge for sustainable Gospel witness.

19

SUNDAY

Pray for Muslim-background believers across North Africa and the Middle East that their faith would mature, their witness would remain courageous, and supportive discipleship networks would continue to grow despite family pressure and social opposition.

Philippians 2:3–4

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

20

MONDAY

Pray for emerging Christian leaders receiving training through GCS initiatives, that theological depth, humility, spiritual maturity, and practical ministry skills would equip them for effective, sustainable, and Christ-centred leadership in the years to come.

21

TUESDAY

Pray for children affected by war, displacement, instability, and prolonged uncertainty that they would experience safety, healing, education, and opportunities to encounter the hope found in Jesus Christ through caring Christian support.

22

WEDNESDAY

Pray for believers across Central Asia serving faithfully under increasing social and governmental pressure, that wisdom, perseverance, and spiritual resilience would sustain their witness and encourage the growth of local fellowships and discipleship movements.

23

THURSDAY

Pray for preparations underway for future GCS training among Muslim-background believers in Cairo, that planning, resources, partnerships, and practical arrangements would come together effectively, producing lasting Kingdom impact.

24

FRIDAY

Pray for prison ministries worldwide, that incarcerated men and women would encounter Christ personally, embrace genuine transformation, and become powerful witnesses of God's grace both inside correctional facilities and beyond their release.

25

SATURDAY

Pray for young believers navigating an increasingly confused cultural environment that biblical truth would shape identity, purpose, relationships, decision-making, and lifelong commitment to Christ amid competing influences and widespread spiritual uncertainty.

26

SUNDAY

Pray for ongoing recovery efforts among war-affected communities in Ukraine, that churches, families, and local leaders would continue rebuilding lives, restoring hope, and demonstrating the compassion and enduring presence of Christ.

Matthew 20:26–28

Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave – just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.'

MONDAY

Pray for Christians living under persistent hostility, discrimination, and social marginalisation, that their faith would remain steadfast and their testimony would draw others toward Christ through grace, courage, wisdom, and perseverance.

28

TUESDAY

Pray for the millions who still have little meaningful access to the Gospel, that God would raise labourers, open new mission fields, strengthen local believers, and accelerate efforts to reach unreached peoples worldwide.

29

WEDNESDAY

Pray for missionary families serving far from home, that their relationships remain healthy, their children flourish spiritually and emotionally, and every household experience God's sustaining grace, protection, wisdom, and encouragement throughout their ministry.

30

THURSDAY

Pray for the more than 3,300 volunteers connected to GCS around the world, that their service would remain effective, Christ-centred, fruitful, and increasingly influential in advancing the Gospel within their communities and spheres of influence.

31

FRIDAY

As July concludes, give thanks for every open door, transformed life, faithful partnership, and act of service. Pray that GCS would continue to advance with wisdom, courage, humility, and an unwavering commitment to the Great Commission.
